The Hub Between Taiwan and the Asian Art Market

Taiwan's location makes it a critical transport hub in Asia. It has diverse and rich cultures and is an important technology stronghold in the world. Since the 1980s, with Taiwan's stable political development and social environment, Taiwan has soon developed into a significant platform among Asian art markets.

According to Sotheby's Asia, the participation of top-tier and emerging Taiwanese collectors in Western art auctions has increased 2.5-fold over the past five years. ART TAIPEI has also observed that in 2025, the number of international collectors grew 1.5 times compared to previous years, mainly from South Korea, Indonesia and Japan, indicating that Taipei is becoming an important hub for collector exchange and art dealing in the Asia-Pacific region. The overall collector base remains centered on mature, high-net-worth individuals aged 35 to 64, while the proportion of younger audiences and new collectors continues to rise, demonstrating stable and sustainable growth potential in the market.

In 2024, Taiwan Art Gallery Association launched the inaugural edition of Taipei Art Week and connected over 100 art institutions across the city, such as galleries, art museums, and foundations, which aimed to promote art industry development and international connections, and position Taiwan as a key hub in the global art market.

ART TAIPEI – The Hub of Art Trading in Asia

ART TAIPEI was established in 1992, which makes it the longest-running international art fair in Asia, not only being the most important promoter and platform for the Taiwan art market, but also obtains long-term support and cooperation with the Taiwan government.

For more than 30 years, ART TAIPEI has worked hand in hand with collectors and galleries, nurturing a new generation of collectors, and contributing to the thriving growth of the art industry. By connecting with other art fairs in Asia and internationally, ART TAIPEI enables global galleries to efficiently enter the Taiwanese market and reinforces its role as a stable hub for art trading in Asia. In 2026, ART TAIPEI is positioned as a hub of "Art and Technology Symbiosis," showcasing Taiwan's unique innovative energy on the international stage.

ART TAIPEI – The Art Network at the Heart of the Tech City

ART TAIPEI 2026 will once again be held in Taipei World Trade Center Exhibition Hall 1, situated at the heart of Taipei's business district, right next to Taipei 101, where international enterprises are located. This platform provides an ideal setting for cross-disciplinary dialogue between art and technology. With over thirty years of experience, ART TAIPEI has developed comprehensive programs and services, and through "Taipei Art Week", it extends the reach of artistic energy throughout the city, making art not only present within the exhibition spaces but also an integral part of the city's culture.

ART TAIPEI 2026 SECTORS

Application Deadline : *Wednesday, May 20, 2026*

To ensure the standard and effectiveness of participation in the exhibition, each year, the ART TAIPEI Executive Committee considers the market and trends, makes adjustments to the sectors planning and amending relevant participation qualifications accordingly.

The applicants will be evaluated according to the application materials they submitted, including the gallery's general information, art fairs and gallery exhibition records in recent years, project proposal, participating artists and artworks for ART TAIPEI 2026. (Please refer to page 8 for details.) The exhibitor qualification will be confirmed once the gallery receives a notification of approval from ART TAIPEI 2026. Submission of an application does not guarantee approval.

Please refer to the following application requirements and restrictions for each sector.

ART TAIPEI 2026 Sectors

General Sector : **GALLERIES**

Exhibitor Package includes: 3.6m-high white wooden partitions; lights; basic furniture; 24-hour security service; full carpeting; cleaning service; exhibitor passes; VIP cards; Vernissage invitations; digital catalogue; website listing.

Public Sector : **AT SPACE PROJECT**



USD 525 per sqm (VAT)

Applicants must be a commercial gallery that has been established at least for one year, with an exhibition space and has held three exhibitions annually.

Booth size ranges from 30, 42, 60, 72, 84, 108, 120 to 156 sqm.

- 1 Booths located next to the main aisle(s) shall be charged an additional fee of USD 140 (VAT) per running meter, and application is only open for booths that are 60 sqm (inclusive) or larger in size.
- 2 The ART TAIPEI 2026 Executive Committee does not guarantee the requested booth size and placements. Booth size difference can be up to 6-9 sqm and the final space allocated to each selected exhibitor may vary according to space constraints. The Executive Committee reserves full rights over final layout and space allocation.
- 3 Only a single gallery application is accepted for each booth. A joint application from two or more galleries, or any individual or entity only engaging in art distribution shall not be accepted.
- 4 Galleries applying for a 30 sqm booth can only exhibit solo or duo show, with a maximum 2 artists to be exhibited. Additionally, only galleries that have participated in ART TAIPEI within three times (inclusive) are eligible to apply for 30 sqm booth.
- 5 Any gallery applying for booth more than 108 sqm shall submit the exhibition plan to the Selection Committee, and shall only be able to apply for the desired booth size upon approval from the committee.
- 6 In order to maintain the quality of the exhibition, there is a limit to the number of participating artists per booth, according to the booth's size. In a 30 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 2; in a 42 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 5; in 60 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 6; in 72 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 8; in 84 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 10; in 108 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 12; in 120 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 15; in 156 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 18.
- 7 To complete the participation procedure, selected galleries are required to clear the first payment USD 8,000 (tax included) within two weeks after receiving the notification of selection. The ART TAIPEI Executive Committee reserves the right to cancel the gallery's qualification if the payment or other matters that should be cooperated are unfinished. If the exhibitor withdraws from the exhibition due to factors that are not attributable to the gallery association, the participation fee will not be refunded or transferred.

AT Space Project

Galleries that apply for and are approved to participate in ART TAIPEI 2026 with a Galleries Sector booth of 60 sqm or above are eligible to exhibit in the AT Space Project free of charge. Galleries with booth sizes below 60 sqm may also apply for the AT Space Project; however, a booth fee of USD 3,000 (VAT included) is required.

The exhibition space may be customized according to the needs of the artwork. The maximum booth size is 36 sqm, and the overall height of the artwork, including any display platform, must not exceed 7 meters.

- 1 Galleries are encouraged to propose large-scale sculptures or immersive installation artworks. Interactive formats are preferred. Additional exhibition walls and lighting may be installed depending on the requirements of the work. If a display platform/stage is involved, it must be submitted together with the artwork proposal, including specifications and graphic layouts.
- 2 Selected projects will receive dedicated media coverage arranged by the Organizer.
- 3 The work on display must be identical to the information submitted, and the specifications and forms of the work shall not be modified in any way on site. If the content of the application does not match the actual exhibition, the case will be reviewed by the Executive Committee and taken into consideration as a reference for the following year.
- 4 To ensure commitment to participation, all selected Exhibitors are required to sign a Participation Guarantee Agreement and pay USD 3,000 upon confirmation of participation. For Exhibitors with Galleries Sector booths of 60 sqm or above, this amount will serve as a deposit and will be fully refunded without interest after the exhibition, provided there are no violations. For Exhibitors with booths below 60 sqm, the amount will be treated as a booth fee and will not be refunded.
- 5 Exhibitors are responsible for all additional costs, including but not limited to transportation, exhibition walls, lighting, and related equipment.

ART TAIPEI 2026 PROCEDURE

Notes:

Please submit all application materials onto the online system before May 20 (Wed), 2026. The ART TAIPEI 2026 Selection Committee reserves the right for the approval of the proposal. Please note that applications submitted after May 20 (Wed), 2026 shall not be accepted. The application fee for ART TAIPEI 2026 is USD 200. Once the gallery is approved by the ART TAIPEI 2026 Selection Committee, the application fee can be deducted from the booth fee. The application fee will not be refunded if the application is rejected.

This application process is divided into two stages, the details of which are listed below:

[Stage one: application and submission of application fee.]

1 Application

2 Application Fee

The application fee is USD 200. If selected, the application fee of the approved applicants can offset the booth fee. The application fee will not be refunded if the application is rejected.

3 Confirmation of Application

Upon receipt of gallery's application documents via the Online application system, the ART TAIPEI 2026 Executive Committee will send a confirmation email. If no confirmation is received within two weeks, applicants should contact the Executive Committee to ensure their application status. Applications without payment of the application fee will not be processed.

[Stage two: notification of selection and submission of marketing material.]

1 Notification of approval

All the applications will be carefully reviewed by the ART TAIPEI 2026 Selection Committee, who shall carefully assess the submitted proposals. The notification of approval shall be sent to the selected applicants via e-mail, and the Selection Committee reserves the right to make any final adjustments. After the application is approved, the Executive Committee will send the invoice of down payment upon receipt of the notification of approval. Please complete the down payment USD 8,000, which, in accordance with the payment schedule, is to be remitted within two weeks after receiving the notification of approval.

2 Submission of marketing material

Galleries that have been selected would need to submit marketing materials in Word sheet format via email.

3 Allocation of booth and final payment

Booth allocation will be made in accord with guideline agreed by the ART TAIPEI Executive Committee. The final payment is to be made within the given time period.

The application for ART TAIPEI 2026 is only completed and accepted after all the following information is submitted via the online application system before May 20, 2026. Please ensure the information submitted is accurate and complete. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. Applications submitted by e-mail or fax will not be accepted. Please contact the Executive Committee office by phone or email in advance if you need any assistance with the application.

Submitting the application means that the gallery agrees with the Terms & Conditions of ART TAIPEI 2026. Please refer to the Terms & Conditions on page 10 before submitting your application.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1 Application

- 1 Decisions on the selection or acceptance of Exhibitors are made by the ART TAIPEI 2026 Selection Committee.
- 2 The Exhibitor guarantees that all the information provided for the application is accurate and that all the works submitted are authentic. If the content of the application does not match the actual exhibition, it will be reviewed by the Executive Committee and considered as a reference for the selection in the next year's review.
- 3 The application does not constitute any claim to participation in the exhibition. The organizer reserves the right to terminate the exhibitor's participation.
- 4 The organizer reserves the right to remove any objects on exhibit if the exhibitor fails to follow this clause.

2 Conditions for acceptance to the exhibition

- 1 Upon submitting the application via the ART TAIPEI online application system, the applicant acknowledges the acceptance of the exhibition regulations as being binding upon the exhibitor, the exhibitor employees, and agents. The regulations are legal binding to both the ART TAIPEI Executive Committee and the applying exhibitor.
- 2 The exhibitor agrees that individual and company data may be processed by the organizer or by a company instructed by the Organizer, and may be forwarded to a partner of the organizer to enable such partner to perform services in connection with participation in the exhibition.

3 Preconditions for participation

- 1 The ART TAIPEI 2026 Selection Committee is the sole and final judge on the participation of the exhibitors, and has no obligation to explain the decision.
- 2 Any applications with project including objects classified under furniture, crafts, or design will not be considered. The decision of the Selection Committee is final and unsuccessful applicants will have no right to claim against the Executive Committee.
- 3 In principle, only those artists/ artworks that are registered and that belong to the application list or to the specialized area may be exhibited. The Executive Committee may demand exact details of the individual goods intended for exhibition. In this case, any items that have not been registered or are not permitted cannot be exhibited, and the Organizer reserves the right to remove such items from the booth, and the cost for removing the items shall be borne by the exhibitor.
- 4 The organizer reserves the right to reject applications from any exhibitors who fail to follow this clause in the next two years.

4 Exhibitor's new-added artists Selection

- 1 After the announcement of the selection result, if an exhibitor wishes to adjust the participating artists, an additional USD 500 selection fee will apply.
- 2 Without the consents from ART TAIPEI Executive Committee, an exhibitor is not allowed to alter the amount of participating artists; the amount of new-added artists is also not allowed to be more than the original amount of artists approved, except for enlarging the booth size.
- 3 In order to avoid excessive differences from the originally submitted exhibition plan, there is a maximum for the number of replacement artists based on different booth sizes. The number of individuals that can be changed is not more than 20% of the maximum number of participating artists. For 30 or 42 sqm booth, only 1 artist can be replaced; for 60 to 84 sqs booth, no more than 2 artists can be replaced and for 108 to 156 sqm booth, no more than 3 artists can be replaced.
- 4 If the exhibition plan approved was a solo show, an exhibitor is not allowed to change the participating artist.
- 5 There will be an onsite examination about the artists and artworks during the fair. Any violation of above situations, there will be deduction point to an exhibitor, which will be taken into consideration of the eligibility of participating in the next year's fair.

- 6 In order to maintain the quality of the exhibition, there is a limit to the number of participating artists per booth, according to the booth's size.
 - In a 30 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 2;
 - In a 42 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 5;
 - In 60 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 6;
 - In 72 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 8;
 - In 84 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 10;
 - In 108 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 12;
 - In 120 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 15;
 - In 156 sqm booth, the maximum number of artists can be exhibited is 18.
- 7 If any of the above regulations is breached, the organizer will deduct points and enforce improvements to be made. Failure to cooperate will affect the eligibility of an exhibitor's application for the following year.

5 Booth Allocation

- 1 Once all prerequisites for participation have been fulfilled, the Selection Committee shall allocate the booth area and location thereof.
- 2 Booth allocation mainly depends on the relevance to the theme of the notified exhibits and on their technical classification, and takes into account the overall layout of the exhibition.
- 3 The ART TAIPEI Executive Committee is not liable to the exhibitor for any consequences arising from the position or surroundings of the allocated booth.

6 Logistics

- 1 Exhibitors are responsible for the shipping, logistics, and processing of items to be on exhibit, including inbound and outbound customs formalities.
- 2 If logistics services are required, the Executive Committee has posted a list of recommended service providers on the official website. Exhibitors are advised to contact the appropriate service providers directly.
- 3 Any exhibits sold during the exhibition period shall not return to the original import country and will be levied import duty/ tax, VAT and sales tax according to the Taiwan Government regulations.

7 Withdrawal

In the event that the exhibitor withdraws from the exhibition due to force majeure, the standard for refunding by the organizer is as follows:

- 1 Where the exhibitor withdraws after been approved for participation, no refund will be possible and the organizer has the right not to accept the application from the exhibitor for the next two years.
- 2 The exhibitor that received approval for participation but fails to make the first payment of USD 8,000 within 2 weeks after receiving notification of participation, is considered to have forfeited their right to participate.
- 3 ART TAIPEI 2026 Executive Committee has the right to retain the participation fee made previously by the Exhibitor, and reserves the right but not the obligation, to reassign the Exhibitor's booth space and location to other accepted Exhibitors.

8 Legal Regulations and Technical Guidelines

- 1 Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring compliance with police regulations, health regulations, and other legal requirements.
- 2 Exhibitors must obey the technical guidelines of the event, in particular regarding the regulations relating to booth construction, booth design, and the extensive safety regulations.
- 3 Note for exhibitors: pillars inside booths contain power sources, fire extinguisher, fire hydrant and air quality detectors, and organizers are required to beautify the pillars in accordance with the Taipei World Trade Center's regulations for décor of the exhibition venue. Only artworks between 3-5 kg or unframed canvas works are recommended to be hung up on these pillars so as to cooperate with the Trade Center with regards to operations related to the pillars and the equipment therein, or the maintenance of said equipment.
- 4 The organizer reserves the right to adjust, prohibit, dismantle inappropriate structures or designs that do not meet the image of the exhibition, or any work that can lead to public safety concerns.

- 5 Exhibitor entitlements, including the number of complimentary lights, the offer of facilities, and the terms of use will be announced in the Booth Design and Facilities Form provided by the ART TAIPEI Executive Committee.

9 Installation and Dismantling

- 1 Exhibitors must follow the installation and dismantling schedule stated in the Exhibitor Manual.
- 2 Booths shall not be cleared before the end of the exhibition.
- 3 Dismantling must be completed within the designated period.
- 4 Upon expiry of this period, the Organizer is entitled to undertake dismantling, removal of exhibits, and their storage at the exhibitor's expense, or to order such arrangements to be made at the exhibitor's expense.

10 Booth Design

- 1 The arrangements of booth size, location, and layout are at the sole discretion of the ART TAIPEI 2026 Executive Committee and will be announced in the floor plan.
- 2 The exhibition booths will be constructed by the official booth-builder of the organizer and must comply with the overall design of the event.
- 3 The organizer reserves the right to prohibit construction of unsuitable or inadequately designed booths.
- 4 Exhibitors are required to submit a booth installation design upon application, which will serve as the basis for the evaluation by the Selection Committee. The design should align with the overall planning and safety regulations of the event, while also reflecting the gallery's curatorial concept.
- 5 The Organizer reserves the right to make adjustments to, prohibit, or dismantle any booth structures or designs that are deemed improper, inconsistent with the image of the fair, or that pose concerns regarding public safety.
- 6 The quantity, allocation, and use of lighting and equipment shall be subject to the official Booth Design and Facilities Form provided by the Executive Committee.

11 Cleaning

- 1 The Organizer will provide general cleaning for public space including the aisles. The exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his own booth.
- 2 Cleaning procedures must be completed each day prior to the opening of the event.

12 Security

- 1 The Organizer will provide public security coverage for the exhibition hall. The exhibitor shall be fully responsible for the safety of all the exhibits and personnel at the booth. The exhibitor is advised to take out and maintain adequate insurance coverage against any risks.
- 2 All items on the exhibition area cannot be taken out without the permission from the organizer during the fair.
- 3 In order to maintain the exhibition's security, please fill out the "ART TAIPEI Release Form" and bring it with the Exhibitor Pass or business card to the Exhibitor Service Center before the artwork is released from the exhibition. After review by the organizer, the artwork will be released.
- 4 During installation and the exhibition, all exhibitors, agents, and employees can only enter the venue with the Exhibition Pass or the Installation & Dismantling Pass.
- 5 The Organizer has the right to terminate the Exhibitor's participation or to remove works on exhibition if the Exhibitor interferes with the exhibition or causes physical danger to the organizer, other exhibitors, or visitors without any refund, and the expenses caused shall be borne by the Exhibitor.

13 Insurance

- 1 The Exhibitor is obligated to arrange artwork insurance for the duration of the exhibition and it should cover the entire period the artwork is in the exhibition venue, including the installation and dismantling period. Each Exhibitor should obtain full insurance coverage for loss or damage to all Exhibits and properties during the fair period. All Exhibitors shall be responsible to adhere to every disaster prevention and safety regulations applicable to the exhibition site, and must obtain insurance coverage for damage or loss due to fire, theft, burglary, breakage, leakage, or water damage, during the exhibition and during transport to and from the event and must also conclude a third-party liability insurance.

2 In any event, the Exhibitor assumes all risks of loss related thereto. The Organizer and staff shall not be responsible for any injuries of exhibitors, related workers, or visitors and for any damages or loss of exhibition materials or decorative display equipment during carrying-in/out of the exhibition period. All exhibitors shall be responsible for the compensation of the damage and loss caused by related workers on other exhibitors, display materials, visitors, or facilities in the exhibition hall. The Organizer will not be liable to any exhibitors for any direct, incidental, or consequential damages or loss to the exhibitor or his property arising from or connected with the exhibitor's participation.

14 Occupation of Booth Space

- 1 Due to the visual presentation of the project light source and the safety of electricity, the Organizer strictly prohibits Exhibitors from bringing light sources, and has the right to remove the lights. Please comply with the regulations, as the onsite examination will affect the qualification of the Exhibitor in the coming year.
- 2 The Exhibitor shall occupy the entirety of its allocated space at the commencement of the exhibition and for the entire duration of the opening hours of the exhibition.
- 3 Any use of space outside of the allocated booth space is not allowed unless approved by the organizer.
- 4 The exhibitor shall not sublet, share, or rent spaces outside of the allocated booth space. For any exhibitor failing to follow this clause, the organizer shall not accept the application from the exhibitor in the next two years.
- 5 The exhibitor's booth shall be constructed in accordance with the regulations set out in the exhibitor's manual. The exhibitor shall comply with all instructions of the organizer and/or its agents in respect to the construction of the booth.
- 6 The Exhibitor's allocated space and floor plan shall be provisional and subject to change prior to the exhibition. The Organizer reserves the right to relocate the Exhibitor's space at any time prior to the exhibition, and if necessary, reduce the space allocated provided that a rebate of the fee is granted to the Exhibitor pro rata to the reduction of the space.
- 7 The exhibitor shall vacate the space at the end of the exhibition or otherwise in accordance with the organizer's request. In the event that the exhibitor fails to vacate the space, the organizer is indemnified against any losses or costs incurred as a result of the exhibitor's failure to vacate the premise.

15 Exhibitor's obligations

- 1 The Exhibitor shall not consume or bring food, beverages, or tobacco products into the booth or any area within the exhibition venue. Exhibitors are requested to use the designated exhibitor rest and dining areas.
- 2 The Exhibitor shall comply with and observe all laws and regulations relevant to the use of the booth during the exhibition, including but not limited to the House rules of the venue and exhibitor's manual.
- 3 The exhibitor shall indemnify the organizer and cannot hold the organizer responsible for any loss, damages, claim, and costs resulting from the exhibitor's use of the space, as well as acts and omissions committed by the exhibitor, its agents, employees, and invitees.

16 Force Majeure

- 1 In the presence of force majeure or any sufficient cause, including third-party default, accidental happening, political and economic events, or orders by authorities, the Executive Committee has the right to postpone an event, shorten or prolong its duration, cancel it, or adapt its operation to circumstances. In all such cases, the Executive Committee shall not be held liable, and the exhibitor does not have the right to withdraw from the contract or to claim compensation or refund.
- 2 Relevant regulations on epidemic prevention measures during the period of the fair shall be in accordance with the regulations of the Centers for Disease Control, Ministry of Health and Welfare, and the Taiwan External.
